Exam format:

Time: 90 minutes

Part A: 10 Multiple Choice 10 marks. These might relate to any Semester 2 content.

Part B: Written responses 20 marks. These will require answers of one-half to a page each. There will be some choice with two questions to be answered.

Part C: Sources 25 marks. The questions on the sources will range from simple comprehension to interpretation and analysis. Your answers in this section must be written in **sentence form**. That is, you may lose marks if your answers are not in sentence form.

Part D: Extended response 20 marks. The question will examine your knowledge and understanding of a WWII battlefield (or area of engagement). You should be able to provide details of where, when, who and why it was fought. You ought to be able to describe their experiences and the outcome of this battle.
