

## Year 9 German Yearly Examination

Time allowed; 1.5 hours plus speaking skills test

Sections:

A: Listening	30 %
B: Reading	30%
C: Writing	20%
D: Speaking	20%

The content of the exam is chiefly based on Units 4-8 of the Katzensprung 2 Text and Workbooks, although you should refamiliarise yourself with Units 1-3.

Reread all reading passages, photo stories and revise the relevant vocabulary lists as explained in class.

Reading aloud also helps train the ear for the Listening Section.

Study the Grammar notes at the end of each chapter in the Textbook.

For the Writing Section check the responses you made in your Workbook and additional notes in your exercise book.

There will be one question devoted to expressing yourself using the past perfect tense.

Pay special attention to irregular verbs and those verbs which take the verb "to be" as the auxiliary verb.

The Speaking Section is based on the BRAVO list at the end of each chapter in the Workbook.
